Abstract Submission Guidelines

1. General Requirements

- Abstracts must present original, unpublished research, reviews, or case studies relevant to the conference themes
- Language: English only
- Presentation format: oral or poster
- Ethics approval required for human/animal studies
- Word limit: 300 words (excluding title and author information)
- Submission deadline: strictly before the date stated
- Only online submissions (unless otherwise stated)
- Review process: All submitted abstracts will undergo peer review by members of the Scientific Committee. Accepted abstracts will be assigned to oral or poster presentations based on the reviewers' recommendations

2. Presentation Formats

- **Oral Presentation:** 10 minutes + 5 minutes discussion
- **Poster:** A0 size, portrait format

Registration: At least one author of each accepted abstract must register and pay the applicable fee to be included in the final program.

Publication: Selected abstracts and full papers may be invited for publication in conference proceedings or partner journals.

3. Structure and Formatting

- **Structure:**
 - Title: max 150–200 characters, concise, clear, no author names
 - Authors & Affiliations: full names, institution, city, country; corresponding author email

- Abstract Body (structured): Background / Introduction, Objective / Aim, Methods, Results, Conclusion
- Keywords: 3–5 words
- Optional: References (max 3–5, Vancouver or APA style)
- **Formatting:**
 - Font: Arial or Times New Roman, 10–12 pt
 - Line spacing: 1.0–1.15
 - Margins: 2.5 cm on all sides
 - Text color: black
 - Avoid excessive formatting; bold/italic only for headings or emphasis
- **Figures and Tables:**
 - Max 1–2 files, JPG/PNG/PDF, ≤2 MB
 - Include title and legend
 - Use high contrast; avoid unnecessary colors
 - Optional supplementary materials (videos, slides) if allowed

4. Disclosures / Funding

- Short statement about funding sources
- Conflicts of interest: declare clearly

5. Submission & Deadlines

- Conference Dates: May 5–6, 2026
- Early Abstract Submission Deadline: March 15, 2026
- Regular Abstract Submission Deadline: March 29, 2026
- Notification of Acceptance: April 10, 2026
- Late-Breaking Abstract Submission (selected topics only): April 20, 2026
- Full Paper Submission for Conference Proceedings: April 30, 2026
- Submit online only, before deadline
- Revisions allowed only until submission deadline
- Confirm confirmation email from organizers

6. Registration Fees

- Early Registration Fee: **€350**
- Regular Registration Fee: **€490**
- Late Registration Fee: **€550**
- Young Scientists Registration Fee: **€100***
- Georgian Participants: **150 GEL****

* A young scientist is defined as a person who has obtained a PhD or an equivalent academic degree within the past five years.
